Order:-

Whereas, the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Nodal Officer, Nagpur vide letter under reference No.1 has submitted a proposal to the State Government for diversion of 0.0168 ha. of forest land in favour of Shri. Ashwin Wilson Sawarkar, At. Zadghar, Tal. Murbad, Dist. Thane for construction of an approach road in village Zadghar, Taluka Murbad, District Thane in the State of Maharashtra;

AND whereas, the State Government vide letter under reference No.2 has submitted proposal to the Regional Chief Conservator of Forests, Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Regional Office, Bhopal;

AND whereas, the Government of India after due consideration, vide letter under reference No.3, accorded 'In-principle' approval to divert the 0.0168 ha. Forest Land for the above project under section 2 of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980. The said approval is subject to fulfillment of certain conditions by the User Agency;

AND whereas, the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State, Nagpur vide letters under reference No.4 has submitted compliance of those conditions to the Government of India;

AND whereas, the Integrated Regional Office, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India, Nagpur, vide under reference no. 5 accorded 'Final approval' to divert the of 0.0168 ha. of forest land in favour of Shri. Ashwin Wilson Sawarkar, At. Zadghar, Tal. Murbad, Dist. Thane for construction of an approach road in village Zadghar, Taluka Murbad, District Thane in the State of Maharashtra under section 2 of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980;

AND whereas, the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State, Nagpur vide letter under reference No.6 has requested State Government to issue diversion order in the matter;

NOW, therefore, Government of Maharashtra hereby directs that the area of 0.0168 ha. consisting of Woodland Protected Forest Land more specifically described in the proposal submitted vide letter under reference No. 1 and as per details given in the Schedule given below, be diverted to the User Agency, i.e. Shri. Ashwin Wilson Sawarkar, At. Zadghar, Tal. Murbad, Dist. Thane for construction of an approach road in village Zadghar, Taluka Murbad, District Thane in the State of Maharashtra.

The diversion shall be effected subject to the terms and conditions mentioned in the letters dated 30.10.2015 and dated 25.09.2022 of Integrated Regional Office, MoEF&CC, Nagpur. This approval for diversion of forest land is also subject to compliance of following conditions by the User Agency-

1. The User Agency shall comply with all the conditions stipulated in the 'in-principle' and 'final approval' letters of Integrated Regional Office, MoEF&CC, Nagpur, referred above. The Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Thane shall ensure the strict compliance of the conditions by the User Agency and shall furnish the report in this regard to Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State, Nagpur from time to time.
2. For ensuring the compliances and for monitoring the duly prescribed activities and also to carry out other statutory duties, user agency shall facilitate unhindered access/entry in the area to the local forest Officer. In case the user agency prohibits the free access or create hindrances, the permission given under this Order for the diversion of forest area for the non-forest use shall be withdrawn.

3. Non-compliance of any of the conditions mentioned in Integrated Regional Office, MoEF&CC letters dated 30.10.2015 and dated 25.09.2022, in this order and Rules & Guidelines made / issued under Van (Sanrakashan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980, shall amount to violation of Van (Sanrakashan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and action would be taken accordingly.
4. In case of non-compliance of any of the above conditions, the Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Thane shall report through the State Government to the Integrated Regional Officer (Central), Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India, Nagpur as per procedure laid down in guidelines under the Van (Sanrakashan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980.

III. Heads of Local Bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies in addition to the relevant offices of the Government are hereby directed to display the same on their notice board for 30 days from the date of receipt for the information of general public.
