Preamble:-

M/s Reliance Infocomm Private Ltd, Nagpur has submitted a proposal for diversion of 0.3094 ha. of Forest land for laying of underground Optical Fiber Cable along the existing RoW from Pathari – Deosarra in Taluka Tumsar Dist. Bhandara in the State of Maharashtra to the State Forest Department. APCCF & Nodal Officer has submitted this proposal to Government of Maharashtra vide letter under referred above.

Order:-

In exercise of powers under general approval given by MoEF&CC, Govt. of India vide Handbook of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Sanvardhan) Rules, 2023) Guidelines-2023 Chapter 4 (para-4.2), Government of Maharashtra is pleased to grant '**In-Principle**' approval to the diversion of 0.3094 ha. of Forest Land under section-2 of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Sanvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 for laying of underground Optical Fiber Cable along the existing RoW from Pathari-Deosarra, in Tumsar Taluka, Bhandara District in the State of Maharashtra.

2. This 'In-principle' approval is issued subject to the following conditions:-

- 1) The legal status of the land shall remain unchanged.
- 2) User Agency shall obtain Wildlife Clearance, before the commencement of work.
- 3) User Agency shall defray the cost of plantation (including ten years maintenance) of 100 trees shall be levied from the User Agency towards Compensatory Afforestation. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species along with 10% RET species of Bhandara District shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided. Details of land proposed for Plantation (Record of Rights & KML File), shall be submitted before Stage-II/Final approval.

- 4) The Optical Fiber Cable Line will be laid within maximum size of the trench of 2.00 meters depth & 0.5 meter width with cable line under the OFC pipeline.
- 5) If User Agency has not submitted bank guarantee or paid security deposit with concern road authority (NHAI/MSRDC/PWD/ZP), the agency shall submit a bank guarantee at the rate of Rs.50/- per running meter and an undertaking to that effect shall also be submitted. If the agency fails to reclaim the land to the satisfaction of concerned Deputy Conservator of Forests, the cost for reclamation will be covered from the bank guarantee.
- 6) If the cable is going to be laid in the formation width of the road, then additional charges in form of bank guarantee shall be given at the rate of Rs.35/- per running meter. Similarly for reclamation of side drain and for tarred portion, the guarantee will be at the rate of Rs.300/- per meter and Rs.750/- per meter respectively. An undertaking shall be obtained from the User Agency that it has agreed to make good any loss to Forest/ Environment while laying the cable in the forest area and during maintenance of the same in future.
- 7) For further maintenance of the project, the agency shall obtain permission from the concerned Deputy Conservator of Forests as and when required.
- 8) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than specified in the proposal.
- 9) No felling of trees shall be done during the implementation of project.
- 10) No new forest area beyond the Right of Way of existing road should be broken for laying Optical Fiber Cable.
- 11) The User Agency shall pay the cost of additional Net Present Value, if required in future.
- 12) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- 13) After completion of the project, User Agency will reclaim the area under RoW suitably.
- 14) The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of the State Government.
- 15) This sanction is subject to the final clearance by the Department of Information & Technology for the project and concerned PWD authorities for the project.
- 16) The User Agency shall compensate the private owners of forest land if any, in accordance with the prevalent laws, rules & guidelines.
- 17) The User Agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.
- 18) All other conditions as may be mandatory under relevant Acts, Rules and Guidelines shall be complied by the User Agency.
- 19) All the conditions stipulated by the Forest Department shall be binding on User Agency.

- 20) The User Agency shall make good of any loss to Forest / Environment.
 - 21) All necessary approvals required for the project as per the prevailing laws of the land would be obtained by User Agency.
 - 22) Any breach of the conditions by the User Agency will be treated as violation of the provisions of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
